

The Vineyards:

We feel that Rosé, which can be made from many different varieties, really shines when made from the Grenache variety from which this wine was made. And Grenache really excels from the Paso Robles appellation in California, where these grapes were sourced.

The Vintage:

2017 started as a very moderate growing season with some heat toward the middle to end of harvest. Since these grapes were harvested before most of the heat, we were able to develop bright fruit aromas and flavors at relatively low alcohols, for a beautifully balanced wine.

Winemaker Notes:

This first vintage of our Marilyn Rosé has resulted in a wine that we feel exhibits all the characteristics consumers expect in a serious Rose. From the delicate color to the effusive aromatics to the clean, crisp palate this wine delivers beyond expectations.

The aromas display a wonderful intensity and complexity of fruit with strawberries, Meyer lemon and hints of perfumed rose petals. Once tasted those qualities are augmented with flavors of tangerines and fresh apples. The mouthfeel is crisp and refreshing as the wine glides across the palate with a wonderful lingering finish.
